

Interim Isolation and Quarantine Guidance for K-12 Schools

If You Test Positive for COVID-19 (Isolate) (Self-Isolation)

Pre-K students are required to follow the 10-day guidance for self-isolation because they are not required to wear masks.

Everyone, regardless of vaccination status:

- Stay home for 5 days.
- If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house.
 - If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.
- Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
 - If school cannot ensure masking for 5 additional days, then case should isolate for a full 10 days.

If You Were Exposed to Someone with COVID-19 (Quarantine)(Self-Quarantine)

Pre-K students are required to follow the 10-day guidance for self-quarantine because they are not required to wear masks.

Individuals who are vaccinated:

Students who have completed the primary series of an mRNA vaccine: (Fully Vaccinated)

- Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
- Test on day 5.

Staff who:

- have completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months, **OR**
- have completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months, **OR**
- have been boosted
- Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
- Test on day 5.

Individuals who are unvaccinated:

Students who are unvaccinated:

- Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
 - If school cannot ensure masking for 5 additional days, then contact should quarantine for a full 10 days.
- Test on day 5.

Staff who:

- are unvaccinated, **OR**
- have completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted, **OR**
- completed the primary series of J&J over 2 months ago and are not boosted
- Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
 - If school cannot ensure masking for 5 additional days, then contact should quarantine for a full 10 days.
- Test on day 5.
