Student dismissal

Please be reminded that the end of the school day is 3:25pm, all carpool students must be picked up by 3:40pm. Any students not being picked up by this time will be sent to aftercare and assessed the \$12 drop-in fee. Any students with an outstanding balance will not be able to purchase concessions and report cards will be held until that balance is paid.

We are aware that emergencies do arise, but please make sure you are communicating with the teacher and the office.

Communication

Transportation
