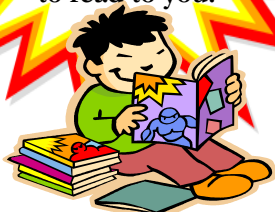
PARENT'S CORNER:

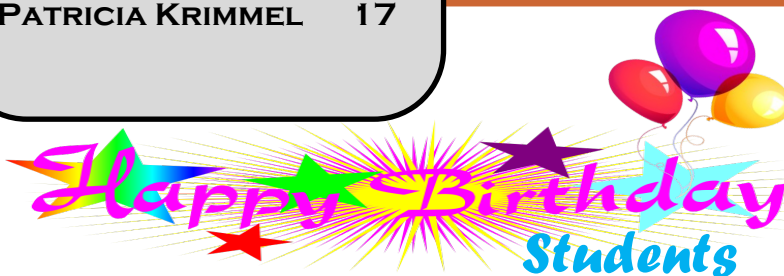
