

## PROPOSED ALIGNMENT GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- 1. Provide students with access to school-building environments that are in a condition appropriate for learning.
- 2. Implement industry best practices to provide safe and secure facilities.
- 3. Increase transportation efficiency and decrease the number of bus routes.
- 4. Provide students with a baseline of rich academic programming, resources and optimal staffing.
- 5. Provide students and families with access to improved feeder patterns.
- 6. Adhere to community-approved tax plan timeline and communicate progress.
- 7. Engage deeply and transparently with neighborhoods and families affected by realignment decisions.
- 8. Develop parent-driven policies for how affected students will be transferred or will matriculate that provide as much stability as possible.
- 9. Set a maximum amount of time that the district will allow a closed school to be empty/unused before being put to other use.
- 10. Adopt and adhere to a set of factors that will be considered in the tiering process (Capacity, Facility Condition, Performance, Annual Cost).
