
BUDGET

OVERVIEW

East Baton Rouge Parish School System (EBRPSS) is committed to creating a more collaborative, strategic, and responsive budget process. During the fall and winter of 2024-2025, the district engaged the community to get input on the budget priorities and process.

FEEDBACK ACTION

The community wants a clear, accessible guide to the budget process and what money is spent on.

FEEDBACK ACTION

The community wants multiple opportunities to learn about and give feedback on the budget early in the process.

Incorporated multiple opportunities for community engagement: An online budget survey, a series of focus groups, and a community conversation on the budget.
