What is SAMR?

SAMR is a model that helps educators integrate technology into their teaching in a meaningful way. It stands for **Substitution**, **Augmentation**, **Modification**, and **Redefinition**. It represents different levels of technology integration in education.

THE SAMR MODEL

The SAMR Model of Technology Integration

SUBSTITUTION

Technology acts as a **direct substitute** with no functional change.



AUGMENTATION

Technology acts as a direct substitute with **functional improvement**.



MODIFICATION

Technology allows for **significant task redesign**.



REDEFINITION

Technology allows for the creation of **new tasks** - previously inconceivable.



REMINDERS:

- SAMR is not a ladder to climb. This is more about finding the right tool for each classroom activity.
