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EBR Schools to Host Magnet Application Assistance Nights at Various Schools

BATON ROUGE, La. — The East Baton Rouge Parish School System is making it easier for families to apply for its popular magnet programs through a series of Magnet Application Assistance Nights in November.

These in-person events will offer families hands-on help with submitting magnet applications at four regional locations across the parish:

- Tuesday, Nov. 4 – Southeast Middle, 15000 Harrell's Ferry Road.
- Thursday, Nov. 6 – Istrouma High, 3730 Winbourne Ave.
- Wednesday, Nov. 12 – Scotlandville Middle, 9147 Elm Grove Garden Drive.
- Thursday, Nov. 13 – Broadmoor Elementary, 9650 Goodwood Blvd.

Each session will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. and is open to any family applying to any magnet program within the district.

"These sessions are especially designed for families who may need hands-on support with the application process," said Elizabeth Thomas, magnet recruiter for EBR Schools. "Our goal is always to make the magnet application process more accessible and convenient for all families across the district."

On-Site Support

During each event, families will have access to:

- Computers and volunteers to assist with applications.
- Spanish translators to support Spanish-speaking families.
- Copiers and printers for printing grades and test scores.

- Magnet team members available to answer questions and provide guidance.

Documents to Bring

- Most recent LEAP scores.
- Last two years of report cards.
- Two proofs of residency (acceptable documents include water/sewage, electricity, gas, mortgage or lease, residential phone, cable, or home insurance statements).

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
