Uniform Policy

1. Navy blue bottoms-standard uniform pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, and jumpers, not more than 5 inches above the knee (No jeans, biking shorts, stretch pants, or sweatpants).
2. Burgundy shirts/blouses allowed with a collar-turtlenecks are acceptable in the winter. Shirts must be tucked in **with a belt** (if there are belt loops).
3. **Pre-K** students will wear navy tops and navy bottoms.
4. Only navy blue or burgundy sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets, or parkas may be worn inside the building (**no hoods**) and any existing winter wear may be worn outside the buildings.
5. Closed-toed shoes/sneakers(no flip flops, house shoes, swim shoes, crocs, slides or sandals)
6. School spirit T-shirts may be worn on Fridays.
7. **No head scarves or bandanas.**
8. **No gloves or hats/beanies worn inside of the building.**
